OSOE MOOC	<i>Since February 2013</i> World Wide	On 2013-02-27 we launched with SUPINFO International University and TU Dresden the first Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) to teach ERPs based on open source ERP5. About 1500 students located in 12 countries have already participated in the MOOC in addition to dozens of anonymous students from other institutions.
